

Assistant Patrol Leader

The Assistant Patrol Leader (APL) reports to the Patrol Leader (PL) and performs the following duties:



1. Helps the Patrol Leader plan and steer the patrol meetings
2. Helps the Patrol Leader keep patrol members informed
3. Helps the Patrol prepare for all Troop and Patrol activities
4. Represents the Patrol at the Patrol Leaders Council (PLC) when the Patrol Leader cannot attend
5. Lends a hand controlling the Patrol and building Patrol spirit
6. Lives by the Scout Oath, the Scout Law and shows Scout Spirit
7. Enthusiastically and correctly wears the Scout uniform
8. Sets a good example for others
9. Assists in training his replacement

This position does **not** count towards Position of Responsibility requirements for Star, Life and Eagle.

Qualifications:

1. No rank, age or prior leadership requirement
2. Has not previously held this position for 2 terms
3. Appointed by the Patrol Leader
