

Assistant Senior Patrol Leader



The Assistant Senior Patrol Leader (ASPL) reports to the Senior Patrol Leader (SPL) and performs the following duties:

1. Helps the SPL plan and run the meetings and activities
2. Runs the Troop in the absence of the SPL
3. Helps train and supervise the Troop Scribe, Historian, Quartermaster, Librarian, Chaplain Aide and Instructors. Replacing them in their duties if they are absent.
4. Serves as a member of the Patrol Leaders' Council (PLC)
5. Lives by the Scout Oath, the Scout Law and shows Scout Spirit
6. Enthusiastically and correctly wears the Scout uniform
7. Sets a good example for others
8. Assists in training his replacement

This position can be used to satisfy Position of Responsibility requirements for Star, Life and Eagle.

Qualifications:

1. Has attained the rank of 1st Class
2. Is at least 13 years of age
3. Has served at least 1 term as Patrol Leader, Troop Guide, Troop Instructor, Troop Quartermaster, Scribe, Historian, Librarian or Chaplain Aide
4. Has not previously held this position for 2 terms
5. Appointed by the SPL
