Bugler

The Bugler reports to the Senior Patrol Leader (SPL) or an Assistant Senior Patrol Leader (ASPL) and performs the following duties:

 He will sound reveille and taps on all camp outs. He may use any instrument he is familiar with or use verbal commands.
Instruments may only be used when their use does not violate the Outdoor Code.



- 2. He will signal "Call to Order" at Troop Courts of Honor, The Feast, or any other event or ceremony where that is appropriate. He may use any musical instrument or verbal commands as he is comfortable with.
- 3. He will have three to five skit scripts ready for each Troop outing and assign these to each attending patrol to perform. He will act as the Master of Ceremony for the campfire introducing the skits or the musician when a camp fire song is to be sung.
- 4. He will assist the Musician with his duties at troop campfires.
- 5. He will fill in for the musician when the musician is unavailable to perform his duties.
- 6. Lives by the Scout Oath, the Scout Law and shows Scout Spirit.
- 7. Enthusiastically and correctly wears the Scout uniform.
- 8. Sets a good example for others.
- 9. Assists in training his replacement.

This position can be used to satisfy Position of Responsibility requirements for Star and Life.

Qualifications:

- 1. Has attained the rank of Tenderfoot
- 2. Active in the troop for at least 6 months
- 3. Has not previously held this position for 2 terms
- 4. Appointed by the SPL
