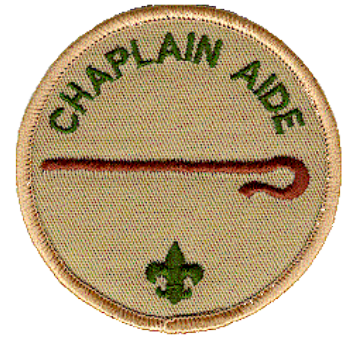


Chaplain Aide

The Chaplain Aide reports to the Senior Patrol Leader (SPL) or an Assistant Senior Patrol Leader (ASPL) and performs the following duties:



1. Conducts the Scout's Own Service on all Troop outings.
2. Maintains the Troop prayer book in good order while holding the position.
3. Performs the prayer at all Troop special events (e.g. Courts of Honor, Eagle Court of Honors, etc.) as needed.
4. Obtains and sends notes of condolence to members of the Troop, their families or anyone else that has been indicated by the Troop Adult Leaders.
5. Obtains and sends get well cards/notes to members of the Troop, their families or other designated recipients that may be injured or ill.
6. Circulates all cards and notes for members of the Troop to sign.
7. Will seek reimbursement from the Troop for any cards, postage, etc. required in the performance of these duties.
8. Advises the PLC of any religious holidays or special days of observance that may need to be considered in the planning of Troop activities.
9. Lives by the Scout Oath, the Scout Law and shows Scout Spirit.
10. Enthusiastically and correctly wears the Scout uniform.
11. Sets a good example for others.
12. Assists in training his replacement.

This position can be used to satisfy Position of Responsibility requirements for Star, Life and Eagle.

Qualifications:

1. Has attained the rank of Tenderfoot
2. Active in the troop for at least 6 months
3. Has not previously held this position for 2 terms
4. Appointed by the SPL
