

# Den Chief

The Den Chief works with the Cub Scouts, Webelos Scouts and Den Leaders in a Cub Scout Pack. A Den Chief can lead games, participate in discussions, help with Scout skills, and more. They provide a link to Boy Scouts.



The Den Chief reports to the Den Leaders of a Pack as well as the Senior Patrol Leader (SPL) or an Assistant Senior Patrol Leader (ASPL) and performs the following duties:

1. Assists in all den meetings activities
2. Communicate regularly with the Den Leader to review the den and pack meeting plans
3. If serving as a Webelos Den Chief, prepare boys to join Boy Scouts
4. Project a positive image of Boy Scouts
5. Know the purposes of Cub Scouts
6. Encourage Cub Scouts to join a Boy Scout troop upon graduation
7. Help out at pack meetings
8. Be a friend to the boys in the den
9. Lives by the Scout Oath, the Scout Law and shows Scout Spirit.
10. Enthusiastically and correctly wears the Scout uniform.
11. Sets a good example for others.
12. Assists in training his replacement.

This position can be used to satisfy Position of Responsibility requirements for Star, Life and Eagle.

Qualifications:

1. Has attained the rank of 2<sup>nd</sup> Class
2. No age or prior leadership requirement
3. Has not previously held this position for 2 terms
4. Appointed by the SPL
