

Instructor

The Troop Instructor reports to the Senior Patrol Leader (SPL) or an Assistant Senior Patrol Leader (ASPL) and performs the following duties:



1. Instruct basic scouting skills, including games and activities, within the troop or patrols
2. Prepares well in advance for each instructing assignment
3. Assists in coordinating Merit Badge Counselor(s) for troop/scout instruction
4. Lives by the Scout Oath, the Scout Law and shows Scout Spirit.
5. Enthusiastically and correctly wears the Scout uniform.
6. Sets a good example for others.
7. Assists in training his replacement.

This position can be used to satisfy Position of Responsibility requirements for Star, Life and Eagle.

Qualifications:

1. Has attained the rank of Life
2. Is at least 13 years of age
3. Has served at least 1 term as Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, Senior Patrol Leader or Troop Quartermaster
4. Has not previously held this position for 2 terms
5. Appointed by the SPL
