

Musician

The Musician reports to the Senior Patrol Leader (SPL) or an Assistant Senior Patrol Leader (ASPL) and performs the following duties:



1. Supplies a musician and/or musical number at all Troop special events (e.g. Courts of Honor, The Feast or any Eagle Court of Honors) as requested
2. Supplies a musician and/or musical number at other events such as recruitment events or ceremonies of recognition upon request
3. Will have four Scout appropriate camp fire songs ready for every camp out and will be prepared to lead the troop in singing the songs
4. Will seek assistance from the Bugler as needed for troop campfires
5. Will fill in for the Bugler when the Bugler is unavailable to perform his duties
6. Prepares well in advance for each event where required to perform
7. Lives by the Scout Oath, the Scout Law and shows Scout Spirit.
8. Enthusiastically and correctly wears the Scout uniform.
9. Sets a good example for others.
10. Assists in training his replacement.

This position does **not** count towards Position of Responsibility requirements for Star, Life and Eagle.

Qualifications:

1. Has attained the rank of Tenderfoot
2. Active in the troop for at least 6 months
3. Has not previously held this position for 2 terms
4. Appointed by the SPL
