

Quartermaster

The Troop Quartermaster (QM) reports to the Senior Patrol Leader (SPL) or an Assistant Senior Patrol Leader (ASPL) and performs the following duties:



1. Keeps records on patrol and Troop equipment
2. Makes sure that all of the equipment is in good working condition
3. Issues equipment to patrols and makes sure it is returned in good condition
4. Makes suggestions for new or replacement items
5. Works with the Adult Troop Quartermaster
6. Keeps the troops trailer(s) neat and orderly. Checks and corrects equipment loads in the trailers monthly preferably during the next meeting after an outing.
7. The Patrol Quartermasters assist QM as needed to perform duties
8. Lives by the Scout Oath, the Scout Law and shows Scout Spirit
9. Enthusiastically and correctly wears the Scout uniform
10. Sets a good example for others
11. Assists in training his replacement

This position can be used to satisfy Position of Responsibility requirements for Star, Life and Eagle.

Qualifications:

1. Has attained the rank of 1st Class
2. Is at least 13 years of age
3. Has served at least 1 term as Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, Troop Guide, Troop Instructor, Patrol Quartermaster or Assistant Patrol Leader
4. Has not previously held this position for 2 terms
5. Elected by the troop
