

Senior Patrol Leader

The Senior Patrol Leader (SPL) is elected by the Scouts to represent them as the top youth leader. The SPL reports to the Scoutmaster and performs the following duties:



1. With Scoutmaster assistance, oversees the planning and implementation of all Troop meetings, events, activities, and annual Troop planning conference
2. Runs the Patrol Leaders' Council (PLC) meeting
3. Appoints other Troop junior leaders with the advice and counsel of the Scoutmaster
4. Assigns duties and responsibilities to the other junior leaders
5. Assists the Scoutmaster with Junior Leader Training (JLT)
6. Lives by the Scout Oath, the Scout Law and shows Scout Spirit
7. Enthusiastically and correctly wears the Scout uniform
8. Sets a good example for others
9. Assists in training his replacement

This position can be used to satisfy Position of Responsibility requirements for Star, Life and Eagle.

Qualifications:

1. Has attained the rank of 1st Class
2. Is at least 13 years of age
3. Has served at least 1 term as Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, Troop Guide, Troop Instructor or Troop Quartermaster
4. Has not previously held this position for 2 terms
5. Elected by the troop
